



Welcome Leading with Safety Ambassador!



Thank you for volunteering your time and talent to deliver a gas and/or electric safety presentation to students and to share its importance with them and their families. National Grid's goal is to help drive sustainable improvements in safety through further engagement with employees and communities. Your Leading with Safety (LWS) presentation will help the company achieve that goal and heighten awareness that could save lives.

In preparation for your LWS classroom presentation, we have provided some helpful planning steps outlined below. Please allow yourself at least four to five weeks to schedule a classroom visit and order presentation materials. Also, you don't have to do this alone! It's recommended you form a team since it's always fun to partner with colleagues, sharing parts of the presentation.

- 1 Find an audience.** Identify a K–2 or 4–5 grade classroom at an elementary school either in your work or home neighborhood, or a school that you have worked with on a previous volunteer project. Call the school's parent coordinator or office to schedule your presentation. Once you've scheduled a visit, please email the details to Christina.Mauceli@nationalgrid.com and she will assist in assigning a Field Operations or Safety Team member (if available) to accompany you on your presentation.
- 2 Review online materials.** National Grid offers free materials for school-age children that teach about electrical and natural gas safety, energy efficiency, renewable energy and ethics. a) Go to ngridenergyworld.com to learn about the Energy Explorer program; b) Go to ngridenergyworld.com/employees/68110-order-materials-presentation-kits and click to download and print out the presentation guides to help you conduct your classroom presentations.
- 3 Review themed booklets.** To get a better understanding of the prepared lesson and discussion guide found in the LWS presentation kit, it's recommended that you familiarize yourself with the booklets *Aunt Sarah and the Amazing Power* (K–2), *My Natural Gas Safety Activity Book* (K–2), *Natural Gas: An Invisible Fuel* (gr. 4–5), and *Electrical & Natural Gas Safety World™* (gr. 4–5), which can be found as e-books at ngridenergyworld.com/student-e-books.
- 4 Review safety videos.** There are suggested videos to share with the students from the Energy Explorer site at ngridenergyworld.com/teachers/66312-electrical-natural-gas-safety-world-video.
- 5 Order materials.** Determine a) if you will give a gas-only or gas and electric safety presentation based on your service territory; and b) how many students per classroom, per presentation. Order LWS presentation kit(s) at ngridenergyworld.com/employees/68110-order-materials-presentation-kits.

Each kit contains 1 teaching/discussion guide, 25 booklets, 25 bookmarks, 25 pencils, and 25 scratch and sniff mercaptan cards. Please allow two to three weeks for shipping.
