- 1 Find an audience.** To start, find a nearby elementary school or one you've worked with before and identify a 4th or 5th-grade classroom. Contact the school to schedule a presentation and email Christina.Mauceli@nationalgrid.com with the details.
- 2 Review online materials.** National Grid offers free materials for school-age children that teach about energy efficiency and renewable energy. Go to ngridenergyworld.com to learn about the Energy Explorer program.
- 3 Review themed booklets.** To get a better understanding of the prepared lesson and discussion guide found in the Sustainability Ambassador Kit, it's recommended that you familiarize yourself with the booklets *Renewable Energy World™* and *Energy Efficiency World™*, which can be found as e-books at ngridenergyworld.com/student-e-books.
